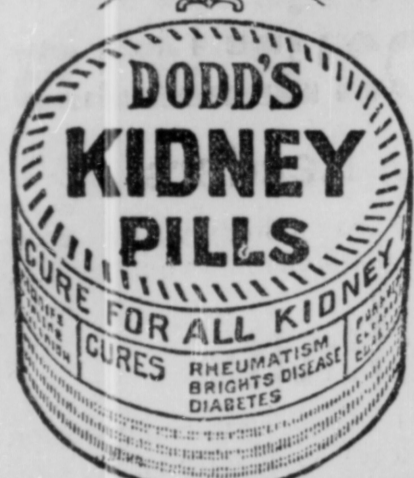

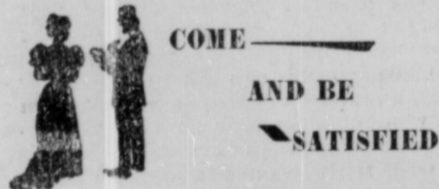

Curious Methods of the Steel Mills.

It has been shown that the quality of the finished steel does not depend alone on its chemical composition, but that the amount of work it receives in rolling or forging and the finishing temperature are also of vital importance. We are still learning year by year better to distinguish the effects due to each and are getting today results that were formerly considered impossible. I refer to the method in use at some American mills, where they roll the steel into plates, shapes, etc., meeting all the requirements of the most rigid specifications without making any preliminary tension tests.

An analysis of each heat or cast is made while the ingots are still, in the soaking pits. From this analysis the ultimate strength is estimated, and without allowing the steel to cool it is rolled on orders where, as shown by the estimated strength, it will apply.—W. R. Webster in Engineering Magazine.

A Peculiar English Custom. The most part of the English usages some of us copy, and the rest of us can get used to, but there is a feature of formal dining there which is different. I refer to the failure to introduce all the company to one another. There are no general introductions at an English dinner or even at the house party in the country. If all the guests are acquainted there is no need to introduce them, but if they are strangers they must remain so or trust to chance or personal magnetism for making acquaintanceships. Every man is introduced at a dinner party to the lady he is to escort to the table. There it stops.
