TORONTO (CP) - Trading was dull and prices were steady on all classes and grades of slaughter cattle at the Ontario public stockyard Thursday.

NEW YORK

NEW YORK (AP) - The stock market tried to rally Thursday but was thrown for a loss by a late selling wave.

Analysts were optimistic about the outlook, citing as bullish factors a 3.6-per-cent increase in new factory orders for durable goods, sharp gains in third-quarter earnings by some big corporations and a record short interest reported by the New York exchange.

The Dow Jones average of 30 industrial stocks declined 1.67 points to 783.68 after having been up more than 6 around mid-day.

The Associated Press 60-stock average eased 0.5 of a point to 284.1, with industrials off 1.0, rails off .5 and utilities up .4.

Standard and Poor's 500-stock index dipped .21 of a point to 77.84. The New York exchange common stock index was off 12 cents at 41.92.

Boeing was off 2 1/2 at 44 1/2 on \$13,500 shares. KLM Royal Dutch Airlines, plunged 17 1/2 to 97 1/2 on 249,500 shares.

Steel, motors, electronics and aircrafts declined. American Smelting lost 1 1/4 and Homestake Mines gained 1.

Volume rose to 6,820,000 shares from 6,460,000 Wednesday. Rails were mostly lower. Oils alone were higher. American Airlines advanced 1 1/4.

Among Canadian issues, Hudson Bay Mining fell 1/4, Massey-Ferguson 1/4, Walker Gooderham 1/4, Distillers Seagraves and McIntyre Porcupine 1/4.

TORONTO

TORONTO (CP) - Prices eased for the second consecutive session on the Toronto Stock Exchange Thursday with western oils the only major group to score a gain.

The market again followed the trend in New York and the industrial index dropped .29 to 143.04 after easing 12 Wednesday.

Massey-Ferguson declined 1/4 to 22 1/2. Imperial Provincial Pipe Line, Imperial Oil and CPR 1/4 each to 7 1/4, 5 1/4 and 5 1/4, respectively.

The oil market moved higher in anticipation of the Oct. 25 sales of oil and natural gas leases in the Rainbow and Zama Lake regions of northwestern Alberta.

Canadian Industrial Gas and Oil climbed 1 to 1 1/2, Union Oil 1/4 to 29 1/2 and Dome 1/4 to 27 1/2. Central Del Rio declined 1/4 to 10 1/2 and Scurry-Rainbow 1/4 to 27 1/2.

BASE METALS GAIN. Among base metals, Noranda gained 1 1/4 to 40 1/2 and Denison 1/4 to 60 1/4.

Prober and Area, which are undertaking a joint drilling project in the Gaspé, continued upward. Prober gained 40 cents to 4.10 and Area 35 cents to 4.05.

On index, golds dropped 1.16 to 155.95, base metals .26 to 80.43 and the TSE .25 to 137.15. Volume was 3,185,000 shares compared with 3,817,000 Wednesday.
