Winter Navigation Costs Seen Lead For Shippers

OTTAWA (CP)—The cost of maintaining winter navigation on the lower St. Lawrence should be carried by the shipping industry rather than the federal government, Thomas M. Bell (P-Saint John - Albert) said in the Commons.

Mr. Bell, who drew support from two Maritimes Liberals and an NDP member, was presenting a private motion asking the government to do three things: (1) to continue to subsidize the cost of winter navigation on the St. Lawrence.

Mr. Bell said the Maritimes do not want to stand in the way of progress but the eastern provinces don't want to pay for it.
