

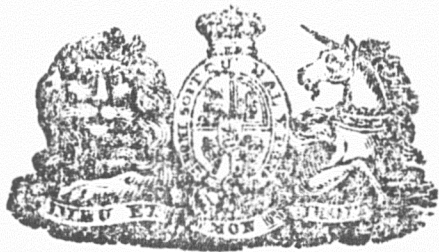

LAWS OF PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND.



An Act to alter a certain Act therein mentioned, relating to the Revenue.

[Passed May 17, 1867]

WHEREAS it is expedient that Grain and Bread Stuffs, the produce of Canada, shall be admitted into this Island free of duty, notwithstanding the same may have passed through the United States, provided the same be imported direct from Canada.

I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, as follows:—Grain and Bread Stuffs of all kinds, the growth or production of Canada, shall be admitted into this Island free of duty, when imported from the said Province of Canada, notwithstanding the same may have passed or been shipped through the United States, on its way to this Island, provided the same be not purchased in the United States, and provided the Owner, Importer or Consignee of such Grain and Bread Stuffs shall produce to the Collector of Impost and Excise for the Port where the same are landed a certificate duly authenticated under the hand of the proper Customs officer or officers in Canada, certifying that the same are the growth or produce of Canada, and also certificates to the satisfaction of such Collector of Impost and Excise, that the same have not been purchased in the United States.

II. Anything contained in the Eighth Section of the Nineteenth Victoria, Chapter one, intit-

ed "An Act for raising a Revenue," and to consolidate and amend several Acts therein mentioned, contrary to the provisions of this Act, shall be and the same is hereby repealed.

III. This Act shall continue and be in force so long as the Act passed during the present Session of the Legislature, intituled "An Act for raising a Revenue," shall continue in force, and no longer.

An Act authorizing the establishment of additional Small Debt Courts at Somerset and Montague Bridge, and for other purposes.

[Passed May 17, 1867]

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, as follows:

I. After the passing of this Act it shall and may be lawful for the Lieutenant Governor in Council to constitute and establish an additional Small Debt Court at Somerset, in Township Number Twenty-seven, in Prince County, and another additional Court at Montague Bridge, in King's County, and to declare the precise localities in the said places in which such Courts shall be respectively holden, and also on what days of each month the said Courts shall respectively hold their sittings, and to appoint to each Court three Commissioners to adjudicate in each Court, and each Court to have jurisdiction only in the County in which it is held, except as in cases mentioned in the hereinafter recited Act.

II. The Courts to be appointed under and by virtue of this Act shall exercise and have the same jurisdiction and powers in all respects as the Courts already established, and having jurisdiction under
