Reduction of Liabilities. 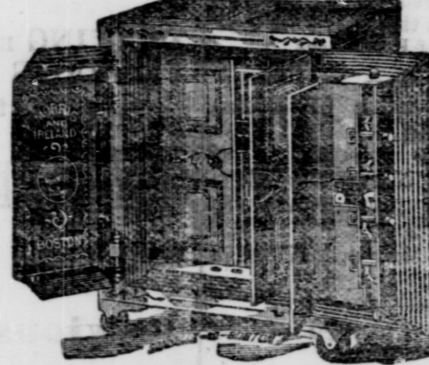
