Scholarships and Bursaries are available for post graduate study. Each week there will be a list in the Cadre and on CIMN of Scholarships and Bursaries. More information will be available on these as well as other Scholarships at Student Services.

St. Dunstan's Alumni Scholarship.

Valued at \$2,000. this scholarship is not renewable except in exceptional circumstances. It is eligible for anyone who is working

towards a Masters or Doctors Degree. This could include an M.D. or a Law Degree. The candidate must be accepted into a graduate program. There are around five scholarships available. Preference will be given to Roman Catholics and UPEI graduates. Candidates must be from the Island

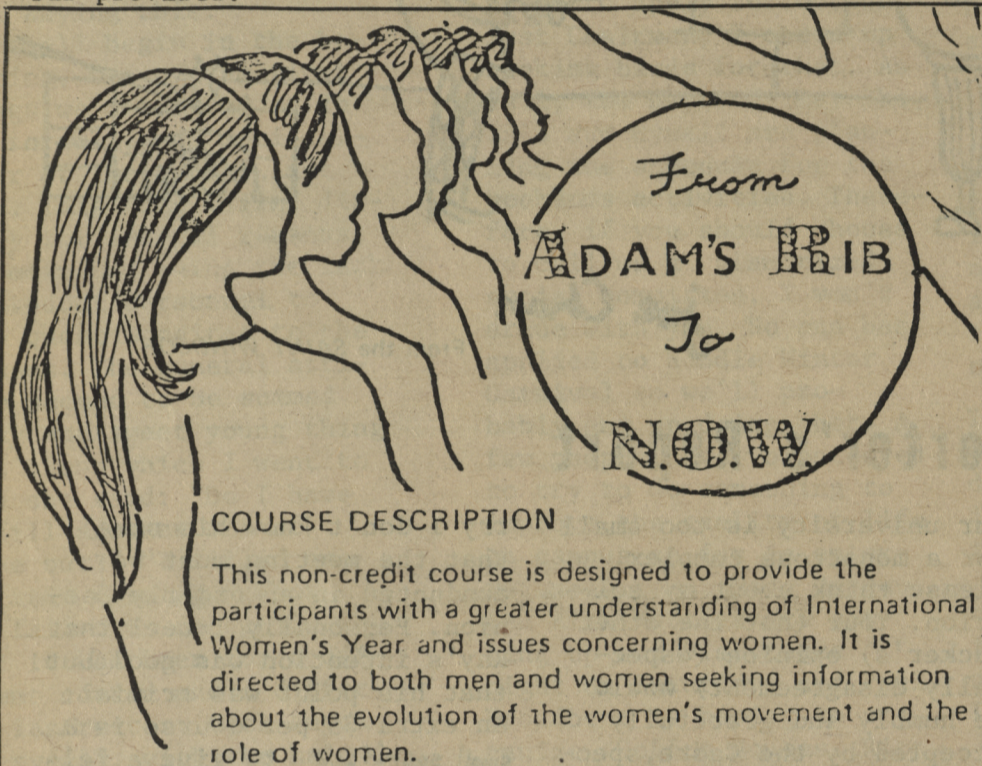
Canadian-Britain Scholarships:

Eligible for students in the Humanities and the Social Studies. Valued at \$3,500. Scholars are expected to return to Canada for at

least one year on completion of their studies. Scholarships are tenable at any university in the United Kingdom. Academic distinction is important but emphasis is also put on leadership and personal qualities.

Canadian Association of Broadcasters Scholarships:

Candidates must be of french Canadian background and interested in pursuing studies in electronics communications (radio and T.V.) Valued at \$2,500/ Scholarship is renewable. Closing date for applications is Feb.28,1975.
