To Treat Burns
What's your favorite method of treating burns? Do you immediately slap on some greasy substance—butter, vaseline, burn ointment or something similar?

Treatment of burns depends on the type, but, generally speaking, if it's a trivial burn—something you get on the stove or iron—wash it off with an alkaline solution (two teaspoonfuls of baking soda to one pint of sterile water at body temperature).
