NEWS NOTES. Washington post office authorities complain that postal parcels addressed to Newfoundland are regularly sent to Canada. They have got a little ahead of time in the States. The Binnetal league, according to a London despatch, has raised £43,000 for the promulgation of its ideas. The skillful disposition of that much gold should make a host of friends for silver. The Chinese warships, Chen Yuan and Ching Yuan, which, according to the despatches, have several times been sunk by the Japanese, are again reported to be afloat and comparatively unharmed. According to a statement made in the year 1874 its population then was 800,000; according to the Tokio official sanitary report recently issued, its population last year was over 1,538,000.
