



HERE'S A SMALL, three-room house with some unusual features and a lot of privacy. Designed by architect J. de Brocades of Montreal, it offers a large combination living-dining room with dimensions of 23 feet, 4 inches by 11 feet, 10 inches.

A large living room window looks out over the patio that screens the main entrance to the house. The bedrooms are grouped at the rear of the house with a dressing room providing access to the bathroom from the master bedroom. An open stairway leads to the basement from the central hall.

The floor area is 1,716 square feet and the exterior dimensions 24 feet, four inches by 44 feet, two and one-half inches.

Working drawings for this house, known as Design 2369, may be obtained from Central Mortgage and Housing Corporation in Moncton at minimum cost.

HAID FOR AILING HOMES

COPPER STAINS
QUESTION: How can I remove copper stains from white stucco? These were made by a copper scroop which has since been treated to prevent future staining.

ANSWER: Swab the stained areas with a strong mixture of household ammonia and water, being careful the solution doesn't get on any painted surface. This solution won't injure stucco. Considerable patience is required.

PECKY CYPRESS FINISH
QUESTION: We are having

pecky cypress paneling installed in our living room. What is the natural? Or try the liberal application of a one-half mixture of varnish and linseed oil.

ANSWER: The usual treatment consists of two or three liberal applications of a one-half mixture of varnish and linseed oil.

RUSTED, STAINED MARBLE
QUESTION: A marble granite bench back yard of a vacation home we recently purchased is badly stained and rusted.

ANSWER: Marble cleaning preparations are available at many housewares and hardware dealers; follow label instructions for use.

CRUMBLING BLOCK
QUESTION: My cellar walls are made of cinder blocks. I noticed, recently, that they are crumbling in a few spots.

ANSWER: The white patches are probably the condition known as efflorescence, which is the result of water vapor passing through the blocks.

REPAIRING RED ORGANS
QUESTION: I have an old organ which needs the repairs. Who could I contact for these?

ANSWER: Consult your local classified telephone directory under "Organ Tuning and Repairing" and "Organs."

PAINTING GLASS PANES
QUESTION: We recently covered an old-fashioned arched window with a glass pane.

ANSWER: Wash the glass with soap and water, or any household cleaning solution, to remove all trace of grease, soil, grime, etc.

Gran Harvesting To Run Into Nov.

Harvesting of one of the best grain crops on record will carry on deep into November if the weather holds out. It is apparent from comments heard from farmers and combine operators in the province and particularly those in the central and eastern sections.

There are reports from a number of areas that some of the land is too wet to permit operation of harvesting machinery. A number of farmers have suggested it will be impossible to get these wet fields out this year, though more optimistic harvesters suggest frost might make the fields firm enough if the snow stays away until the fields could be cut.

James Gordon Abney estimated last night that approximately 25 per cent of the grain is still uncut. A combine operator, he has orders for enough cutting to keep him occupied for weeks if the weather is favorable.

C.A.P.E. CANAVERAL, Fla. (AP) The Explorer XV satellite roared into orbit Saturday night to study an artificial radiation belt formed by the United States high-altitude nuclear explosion last summer.

A Thor rocket propelled the payload into space at 7:15 p.m. and seven hours later the National Aeronautics and Space Administration reported a successful orbit was achieved.

The 95-pound package settled into a wide-orbiting course ranging from 100 to 10,000 miles above the earth.
