— must be entering or continuing studies at U.P.E.I. or Holland College

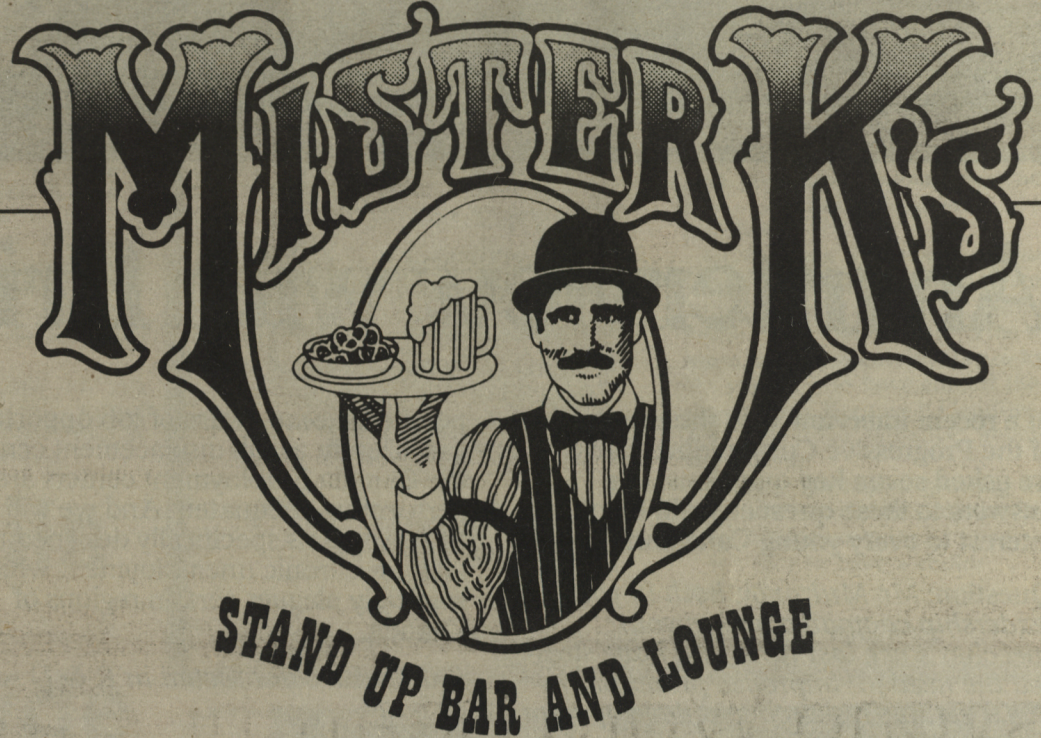
Value: — \$2,000
