## N. Y. Stocks

NEW YORK (AP)—Coppers took a drubbing Wednesday as the stock market advanced to its second straight record high.

Losses were between 1 and 3 points in coppers after the British government indicated readiness to sell 45,000 tons of the metal from its stockpile.

Although minus signs dotted the list gains of 1 to 3 points were frequent.

Motors made the best showing with Chrysler leading. Strength in key railroad stocks boosted that division.

Steels and aircrafts closed mixed. Oils were up. Most chemistries were higher. Companies making Salk polio vaccine were unchanged to higher.

American Tobacco raised prices on two brands and added a point at 69. Reynolds Tobacco "B" 7 1/2 was up 1 1/2 at 43 1/2.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks advanced 40 cents at \$153.70. The average is at its highest since the market opened on March 4 was surpassed Tuesday.

The industrial component gained 30 cents at a record \$220.80, railroads were up 70 cents at a high since 1929 of \$133.70 and utilities were up 30 cents at \$71.80.

There were 105 highs and four lows.

Volume was 2,820,000 shares against 2,770,000 Tuesday.

The American exchange was higher on volume of 880,000, against 940,000 Tuesday.

Lowest Canadian issues on the New York exchange included Canadian Pacific, off 1/4, and Dome Mines, Hiram Walker and Distillers Seagram, each down 1/4.

McIntyre was up one at 7 1/2.

On the American exchange Lake Shore dropped 1/4.
