WINNIPEG, March 10 — (CP)— Grain prices generally displayed strong tone today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange in sympathy with upturns on United States markets.

Trading was dull at the opening here but increased in activity as the session proceeded.

Highlighting the trade was aggressive buying by American interest in rye, believed in connection with export business in this commodity.

Exporters picked up barley. American interests also purchased oats along with shippers. Flax uncovered some shipper and processor demand.

Export loadings of Canadian wheat at the week-end included 730,000 bushels for the United Kingdom, 65,000 for Bolivia, 170,000 for Italy and 385,000 for Peru.

Class two wheat and I.W.A. prices remained unchanged from Saturday.
