5 Projects Announced

OTTAWA (CP) — Five projects in the Atlantic provinces were announced here by Works Minister McIlraith.

Largest was a \$105,516 contract for a railway overpass near Whitebourne, Nfld., awarded to M. A. Rose and Son Ltd. of St. John's Nfld.

The overpass will take a CNR line over an access road leading to the Trans-Canada Highway. The \$4,040,000 road also is being built by Rose and Son.

Dredging at Branch, Nfld., \$45,600 contract by Babh Construction of Harbor Grace, Nfld.

Wharf construction at Iron Bound Islands in Labrador, \$34,820, by Gid Sacre Ltd., Woodstock, Nfld.

Wharf extension at John's Island, N.S., \$31,975, by Shelburne Contracting Ltd., Shelburne, N.S.

Wharf extension and repairs at Mount Arlington Heights, Nfld., \$30,082, by Power Construction, Dunville, Nfld.

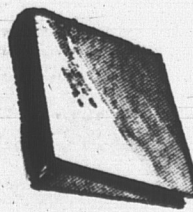
