WINNIPEG, July 2 - (CP) - Coarse grain futures prices showed a firm undertone on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange today. Trading was fairly active and in line with advances on U.S. grain markets. Oats and barley brought aggressive demand from exporters and shippers. Trade reports said three cargoes of Canadian barley were sold to Japan and another sold to the continent. U.S. shippers also took oats, suggesting export business. Seaboard houses took flax and some U.S. support was evident in rye. Overnight loadings of Canadian wheat for export were United Kingdom 335,000 bushels, Belgium 700,000, Netherlands 370,000, India 700,000, Switzerland 20,000 and Yugoslavia 320,000.
