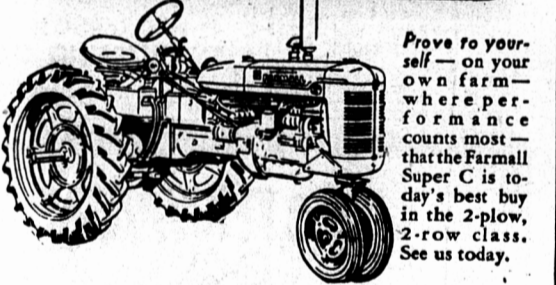

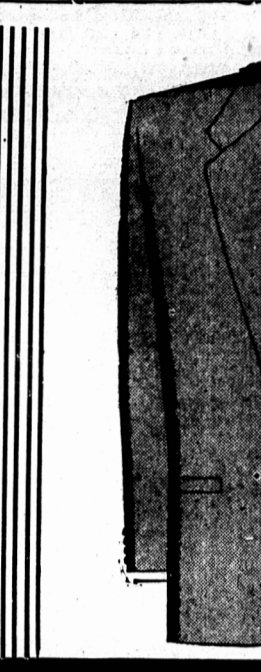
The fishermen of Savage Harbour were very disappointed on Wednesday noon when they could not get out to run their rope on account of very heavy fog.
