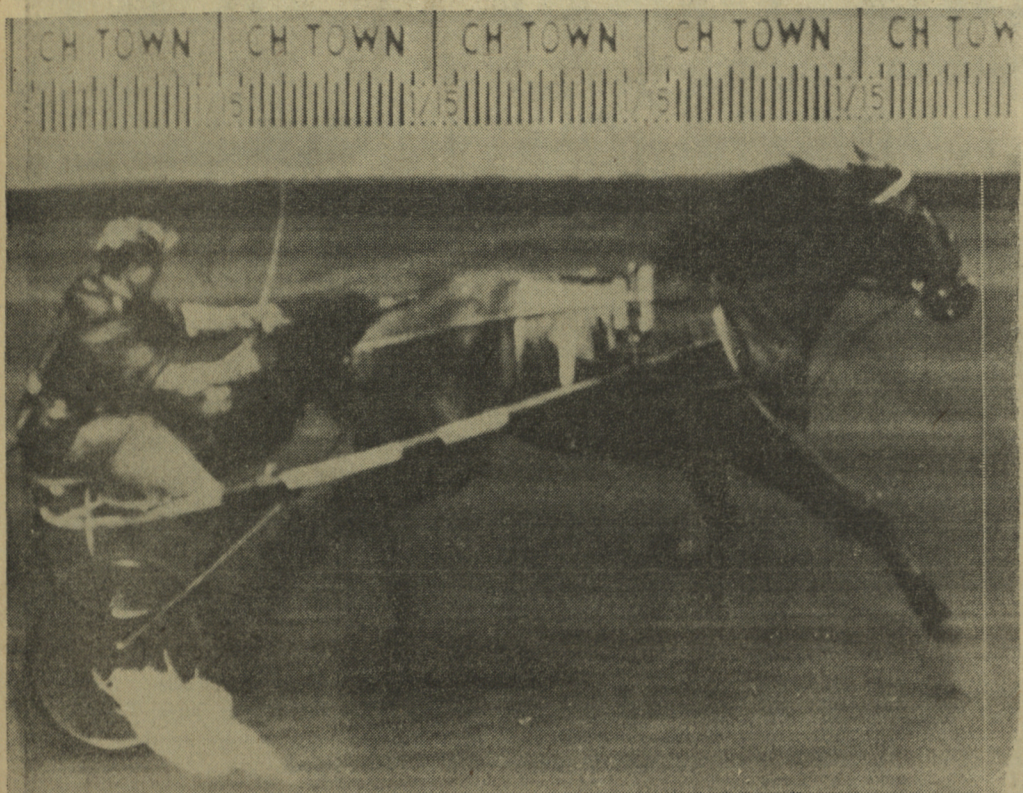

Sky Prince p. 2.03 3-5 is a 6-year-old bay gelding by Sky Raider 2.02 4-5, a full brother to Greyhound, 1.55 1-5. He took his record in 1957 and was three times first, twice second and four times third, with total winnings of \$7,198, at the end of that year. The owner's statement was that he is absolutely sound and has improved every year. He took a win-race record at Roosevelt Raceway half-mile track of 2.05 3-5 in 1957 and also won at Rockingham track and Roosevelt Raceway this year. His season's earnings at the time of the sale were more than \$6,000. He was purchased by Ray Stewart, Murray Earbar, P. E. I.

Slave Girl, 1, is a bay filly by Farvel, dam, Perk Up by Follow Up, dam of four with records from 2.04 3-5 to 2.09 2-5. The new owner is R. R. Brown, Woodstock, N.B.

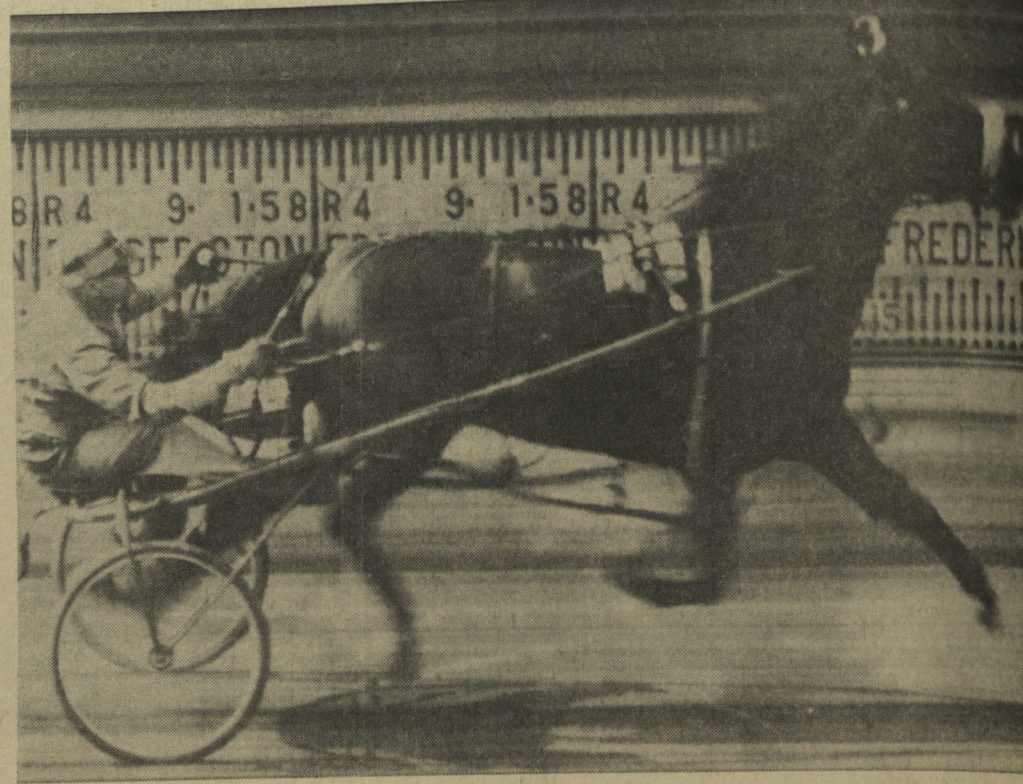
Leon's Thoughts, a yearling bay filly by Deep Thoughts p. 2.00, sire of seven with records of better than 2.10. Her dam is Leon's Lady p. 2.10, dam of Ione G. p. 2.06 2-5. This filly is described as being by a rising young sire and out of a good producing dam from a great producing family. Her new owner is Leonard Barrieau, Lakeburn, N. B.

Splurge is a yearling brown colt by Direct Rhythm p. 1.56 1-5, fastest son of Billy Direct 1.55, dam, Lulladell by Volomite 2.03 1/2, dam, Dell Frisco p. 3, 1.59 1/4, dam of Friscoway 3, 1.59 1-5. Stormaway 2.01 2-5 and six others with records better than 2.07 4-5. This chap is extremely well bred, his dam having been a former world's champion pacing filly. He cost R. R. Brown, Woodstock, \$2,300 and looks like an excellent buy.

Lord Knight p. 3, 2.08 3-5 is a 3-year-old bay gelding by Lord Volomite p. 3, 2.01, dam, Knight Stepper p. 2, 2.04 1/2 — her first foal. Lord Knight took a breeders record of 2.08 4-5 on April 23 and is recommended as a useful horse for the raceways. The new owner is P. J. Cadegan, Glace Bay, N.S.

Another purchase made by Mr. Cadegan is **Hootmite**, a 2-year-old chestnut colt that was trained up to 2.25 last April and then turned out. He is by the super-sire Hoot Mon 3, 2.00, dam, Mighty Symphony. She is the dam of Plainsman 2.03 1-5, Mighty Nibble 2, 2.06 1-5 and his grandam is Symphonita 2.03, one of the real great brood mares.

Bertram Hanover 2.03 3-5 is an 8-year-old bay gelding by Titan Hanover 3, 1.58, dam, Bertha Hanover 3, 2.08 3-5, one of the great brood mares at Hanover Shoe Farms, and his grandam is Miss Bertha Dillon 4, 2.02 1/2, dam of three with records of 2.00 or better. This horse is bred in the

purple and he had picked up over \$7,000 this year and won impressively in the rain at Yonkers, Oct. 14. The distance was one and one-sixteenth miles. His new owner is Sam Johnston, Charlottetown, P. E. I.

Victory March 4, 2.06 2-5 is a real good gaited trotter that won at Rockingham, N. H. half-mile track over very heavy footing November 6th, in 2.13 2-5. He should 2.10 over our tracks. The new owner is Stanley Mayhew, Kinkora, P. E. I.

Duchess Scott p. 2.08 1-5 was purchased by Harry Hirsch of Sydney, N.S. at the Delaware sale. Harry had to pay \$5,200 to become owner of this valuable mare, that was 10 times first, 3 times second, twice third and once fourth in 16 starts this season. Her sire is Thomas B. Scott p. 1.56 1-5, also the sire of the good trotter, Miss Tom Scott that raced in the Don Seaman stable this year and is owned by Andrew Perry of Summerside. Other buys there were:

Victory Scott p. 2.02 2-5 is an 8-year-old pacer by Victory Song 1.57 3-5, that was knocked down for \$5,000 to Don Seaman acting as agent for a buyer here. Prior to the sale he had raced in California and we understand that his winning time was better than 2.02.

Lady Rodney 2.07 by Rodney 1.57 2-5, dam, Indian Lady, dam of Indian Blaze 2.08 2-5 and several others, is a trotter that has been in 2.07 on a half-mile track and will be a very valuable addition for the fast trotting

classes in the Maritimes. She was purchased by George H. Alexander, St. John, N.B.

Another St. John purchase was **Lewie Jayzoff**, a 10-year-old trotting gelding by Little Pat W. 2.10, sire of several with records better than 2.10. The new owner is A. Alexander.

Tennessee Commander 2.07 2-5 is a 5-year-old by Lieutenant Commander and was eligible to the 2.21 pace at the beginning of the season. He and the 3-year-old Sandra Time by Time Table was purchased by St. John parties in September.

Mighty Lee p. 4, 2.05 1-5 is a 5-year-old roan gelding by Mighty H., that in 1957 was 10 times first, 4 times second and 5 times third. He is sound and has been meeting some of the better pacers at Roosevelt and Yonkers Raceway, a well informed horseman believes that he should pace our tracks in 2.07 or faster. His new owners are Willard MacDonald, Summerside, and Rankin McLane, Charlottetown.

His total earnings as a 3-year old were \$77,785, and with his previous earnings as a 2-year old it ran his total up to \$106,689. Sunbell, that started as a green 3-year-old, won the \$11,776 Lady Ship Stake at Goshen, N.Y. in (Continued on Page 9)

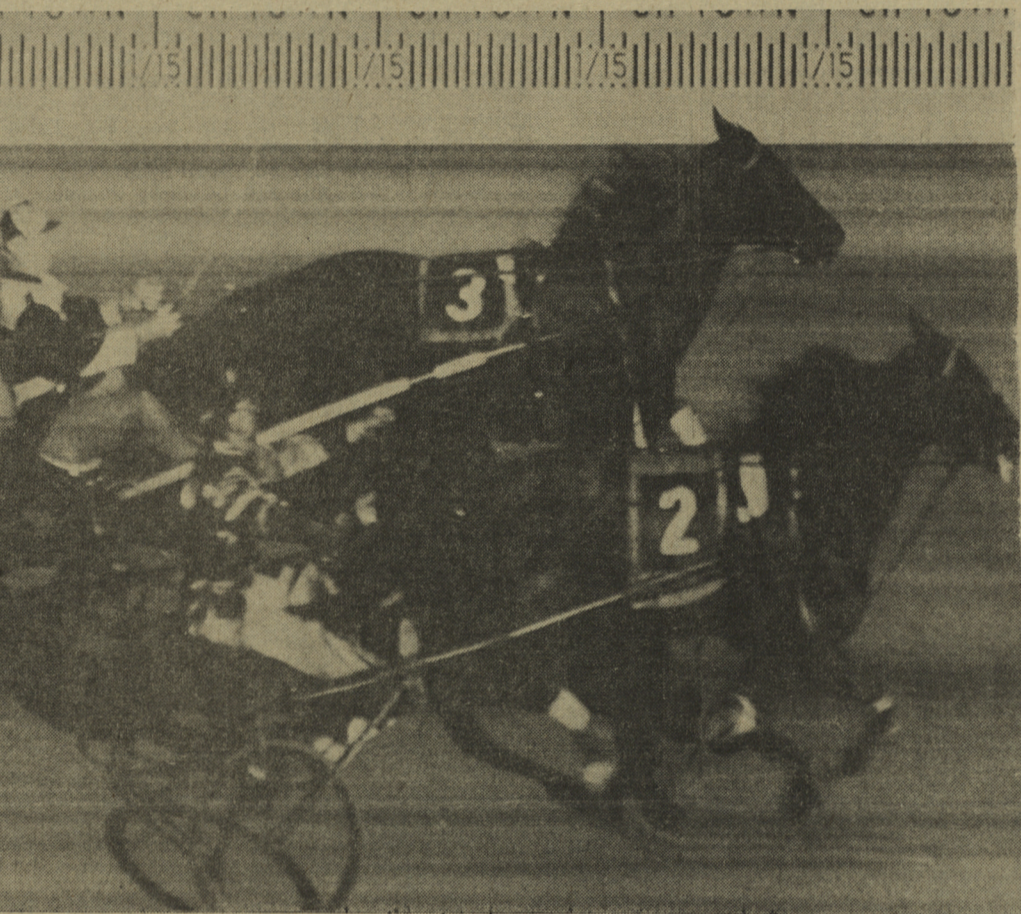

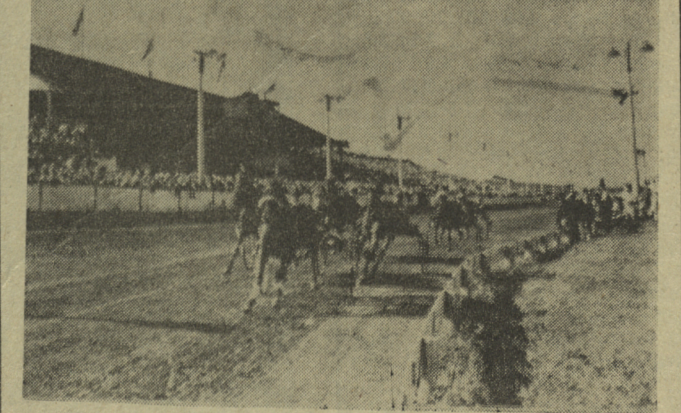
