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Cook's Corner

BEEF STEW WITH DUMPLINGS

A further shortcut in making this dish, would be the use of a prepared baking mix—it will produce very fluffy, tender dumplings in a minimum of time. Yield—6 servings.

- 1/2 pound stewing beef
- 2 tablespoons shortening or beef dripping, heated
- 2 1/2 cups water
- Salt
- 2 tablespoons flour
- 2 cans (10 ounces each) condensed vegetable soup
- 1 1/2 cups once-sifted enriched pastry flour or 1 1/2 cups once-sifted enriched all-purpose flour
- 3 teaspoons baking powder
- 2 tablespoons chilled shortening
- 1/2 cup (about) milk

Wipe the beef with a damp cloth and cut into 1/2-inch cubes; add to the 2 tablespoons heated shortening or dripping and fry until cubes are richly browned. Pour off excess fat.

Pour 2 1/2 cups of the water over the meat. Add 1/4 teaspoon salt. Cover closely and simmer until meat is tender—about 45 minutes.

Measure the 2 tablespoons flour into a bowl and smoothly blend in the remaining 1/4 cup water; stir into meat mixture and cook, stirring constantly, until smoothly thickened.

Add the 2 cans of soup and mix well; bring to the boil.

While soup mixture is heating, make the dumplings.

Measure the 1 1/2 cups once-sifted pastry flour (or 1 1/2 cups once-sifted all-purpose flour) into sifter and add baking powder and 1/2 teaspoon salt; sift together once, then sift into mixing bowl. Add the 2 tablespoons chilled shortening and cut it in finely. Make a well in the flour mixture and add 1/2 cup milk; combine lightly, adding a little more milk, if needed, to make a soft drop dough.

Drop dough by spoonfuls onto simmering stew, making 6 large spoonfuls.

Cover and simmer, without lifting the cover, 15 minutes.

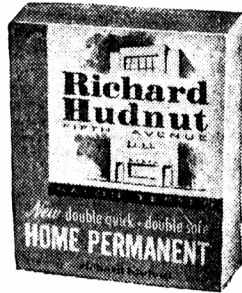
