

### Announce Plans For Civil Defence Program In N.B.

FREDERICTON, Jan. 24 (CP) — Plans for a first aid civil defence program in New Brunswick were announced tonight by Hon. F. A. McGrand, minister of health and social services and provincial director of civil defence.

Dr. McGrand proposed establishment of 12 first aid stations, with training equipment and supplies provided by the Federal Government without cost to the province or municipalities. The plan would be a first phase objective of the health services committee of the New Brunswick civil defence co-ordinating committee.

Three first aid stations would be in Saint John and one each in Moncton, Fredericton, and the counties of King's, Charlotte, Carleton, Madawaska, Restigouche, Gloucester and Northumberland.

The sites would depend largely upon the availability of medical personnel and health facilities as well as the relation to target areas, and each would serve as the nucleus of an emergency setup which could be augmented as warranted.

Dr. McGrand said the Federal Government will buy and stockpile, on a regional basis, sufficient emergency medical supplies to care for 50,000 casualties.

### Halifax County Teachers Prepare For Strike Action

HALIFAX, Jan. 24 (CP) — A spokesman said today "scores of teachers" in Halifax County anticipating a strike are preparing to file applications for jobs with the National Employment Service.

The some 400 teachers have threatened to strike Feb. 1 to enforce wage demands, turned down yesterday by county authorities who said the total cost would be \$200,000, more than the county could afford.

F.A. Lewis, salary committee chairman in the Dartmouth branch of the Nova Scotia Teachers' Union, said requests for application forms have been made to the N.E.S. Another development was "the passing of a resolution to be circulated to all locals in the province calling for the blacklisting of any school section which attempts discriminatory action now or later against any union member."
