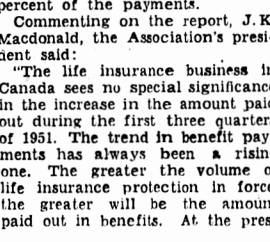
Life Insurance Benefits Reach Record Volume
