

HORACE VERNET: A POET AND A SINGER.
The *Moniteur des Arts*, in an article on Horace Vernet, mentions the following anecdotes of his life: "The late painter was eminently kind and hospitable. His comrade sent him on to get his likeness taken, and sent him to Vernet, with the purpose of having his portrait taken in full length. Vernet saw through the trick, and painting for the handsome soldier a magnificent portrait, turned the laugh against the painter.

RELIEF FROM THE TYRANNY OF GAS.—M. Manguet, a French physician, announces his intention of freeing us from the tyranny of gas, and providing a light at once infinitely cheaper and more efficient. This is to be accomplished by passing atmospheric air through a fluid containing a substance which has the property of absorbing the gas. The generating apparatus is simple, the light seven times as powerful as gas, and the real question seems to be the absence of expense. The promoter of the invention, however, says that, in case of emergency, he can supply the gas, precipitate it from the floor of the furnace, and at the worst, only render the latter inflammable when coming in contact with fire. Gas, as at present used, may also be passed through the phlogestone with a saving of fifty per cent in consumption, and a gain of five per cent in illumination. The apparatus said to have been largely adopted in France.

A NEW QUADRUPED.—A new quadruped has been discovered in Madagascar, and an agent of the French Academy of Sciences was forwarded to take an account of it. It belongs to the genus *Indris*, and is described as having a stout like that of a King Charles spaniel, the skin of the face being covered by a brilliant jet black tint. Its fur is long and woolly; its paws, or rather hands, are bare, and its long, slender fingers are the longest; the thumb of the hind paws (replacing the great toe) is very thick and flattened. The whole animal measures eighty-six centimetres, fifteen of which belong to the tail. The cry of this animal resembles that of a human being in distress, and when there are several together they form a very disagreeable noise.
