

APPEAL MADE ON SENTENCE

MACON, Ga. (AP) — A minister said Tuesday he will appeal a 60-day sentence in the city jailhouse imposed on a charge that he made too much noise while worshipping.

Rev. Wilburn M. Simmons was sentenced in city court despite a plea by a member of the Church of God that the pastor "was just praising the Lord."

Brother Simmons just shouts and sings when he feels like it, when he feels compelled to, the member testified Monday.

The charge was brought by a person living near the church. He said drums, a piano, other instruments and singing by Simmons created a din that lasted late into the night.

Another church member, a storekeeper, said that services were loud enough for him to hear at his store six or seven doors down the street.

Simmons was freed under a \$1,800 appeal bond.

Irish Get Tax Boost

DUBLIN (AP) — Tax increases paralleling the boost announced in Britain were imposed Tuesday by the Irish government, which has an industrial boom under way.

Finance Minister James Ryan told the Dail parliament that increases ranging from one to three pence 1.6 cents to 2.5 cents are being applied to taxes on cigarettes, beer, imported whisky, gasoline and milk.

He also announced tax relief for farmers, slight boosts in old-age pensions and higher income tax exemptions.

Plane Blast Unexpected

CAPE KENNEDY, Fla. (AP) — Eleven engineers and technicians were burned, four critically, Tuesday when a rocket engine being joined with a space payload ignited unexpectedly in a checkout building.

The National Aeronautics and Space Administration reported the payload—an Orbiting Solar Observatory — had just been mated with the rocket stage when the engine suddenly ignited. The rocket was to have been the third stage of a Delta space booster.

The stage lifted off the stand and exploded, blowing the 400-pound OSO payload loose in the 304-foot room.

There was no explosion, a NASA spokesman reported. But he said there was considerable fire from the 2,000-hp thrust rocket.

The spacecraft and building were damaged extensively.

Illionis Man Dies Tuesday

WASHINGTON (AP) — Representative Thomas J. O'Brien, powerful dean of Illinois Democrats in the U.S. House of Representatives, died Tuesday in Bethesda Naval Hospital. At 85, he was the oldest member of the House.

O'Brien was rarely heard on the House floor or in the ways and means committee on which he was third-ranked Democrat, but he was a power behind the scenes.

This was because he could usually deliver, virtually on demand, the votes of all the Illinois Democrats.
