# Local and Other Items

**A NEW IDEA.**—A bill is pending in the Michigan Legislature to license at \$5 each every man who wants to drink liquor. He must carry his license with him and present it when a drink is ordered.

**WINSLOE CHEESE FACTORY.**—The construction of the new factory for the Winsloe Dairying Company is rapidly progressing under the construction of Rackham & Saunders, contractors and builders. It will be the model factory of the Island when completed and will be equipped for making both butter and cheese. The completion of this factory is due to the mechanical engineering of Mr. Benjamin Carter, who is inspector of said contract, and who has laboured hard with the new factory to surpass any of its kind in the Province. The company expects to be making cheese in the new structure about the 15th of June next, under the management of Mr. Caryer.

**WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY.**—According to a statement made to the correspondent of the Associated Press in London by the secretary of the wireless telegraphy company the first attempt to transmit Atlantic messages by the Marconi system will be made during the contests for the American cup. Stations will be established at Saady Hook, and elsewhere along the course laid out for the great yacht race, from which the entire contests will be visible. Messages recording the passage of the races will be transmitted from these stations to a point on the Irish coast in the neighborhood of W.terville. The agent of the wireless telegraph company added that Sir Thomas Lpton, and the authorities of the United States and Great Britain, had been notified of the project, and had expressed themselves as being interested.
