For honour we would die;

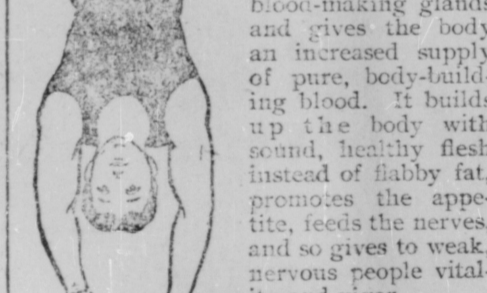
Our quarrel is just therefore we're armed,

Sours at 6 a. m., arrives Charlottetown 10.10 a. m.; leaves Charlottetown at 2.10 p. m.; leaves Georgetown 5.25 p. m., and Sours, 6.20 p. m., leaves Charlottetown 3.10 p. m., arrives Summerside 6.20 p. m. The Cape Traverse branch train will leave Cape Traverse at 6.45 a. m., arrive at Emerald 7.35 a. m.; leave Emerald at 5.15 p. m., arrive Cape Traverse 6.05 p. m. Standard time is used.
