**ARRESTED FOR PERJURY IN TIME-BOMB TRIAL**

Latest development in the time-bomb trial that killed 23 persons last September in province of Quebec was arrest of Mrs. Marguerite Pitre for perjury. Noel Dorian, chief crown prosecutor for case now under way in Quebec City, had Mrs. Pitre, one of star witnesses, arrested after she had finished testifying against her 51-year-old brother, Genereux Ruest, because she allegedly contradicted a statement made at Ruest's preliminary hearing. Her brother is on trial for murder for his alleged part in making the firing device in a time-bomb that jeweler J. Albert Guay used Sept. 9 last year to kill his wife, Rita, by time-bombing a plane that crashed and killed all 23 persons on board. Guay is awaiting the death penalty.

weather: when we arrived here was lovely but later cohere was frost, and a week of cold weather" grand-aunt to our small ones wrote from Florida in a letter received today. An interesting missive to us who find it difficult to imagine that at this season Summer reigns in other lands. That skies there are softly blue and bedecked with lazy clouds; that shimmering waves break gently on warm sands; that song-birds carol and flowers and trees spread a riot of color. "One morning" she continued "the glass was at 33. But yesterday the mercury was at 80 and today it was 78. During the cold weather we were fortunate in having a wood-stove in the kitchen—a little bit of a thing but a fine heater... The frost hurt the flowers somewhat. Before that the Poinsettias were lovely... The fruit is not quite ripe yet—but we eat it, just the same!"
