State Secretary Cautions People

WASHINGTON (AP) - State Secretary Dean Rusk said Tuesday "we are not over the hump yet" toward achieving peace in Viet Nam despite recent military gains.

"We haven't begun to see the end of this thing yet because we haven't seen yet any decision by the other side to bring this to a conclusion," Rusk said. At a press conference following a two-week trip through the Far East, Rusk in effect cautioned against "over optimism about the Viet Nam situation in the wake of military achievements."

He was asked about the possibility of a quick end to the war now that the bombing of oil facilities in the Hanoi-Hai-phong area and elsewhere in North Viet Nam has damaged the ability of the Communists to send men and supplies south against the government of South Viet Nam.

"We haven't seen a change in heart on the other side," Rusk said. He did not evaluate the military effectiveness of the oil attacks in specific terms, but said any move making North Viet Nam's infiltration more difficult "cannot help but affect their judgment on their future course."

In the meanwhile, Rusk said, "it seems to me our present course is clear. To support our men in uniform and our allies" and "proceed as rapidly as possible" with development in civilian fields too, in economic and social programs.

LONDON (CP) - Fans at the World Cup soccer matches in Britain will have to buy beer and cider in plastic containers instead of glass bottles. This is to protect players from rowdy spectators.

OTTAWA (CP) - Licence applications for a new privately-owned television station at Causapsal, Que. in the Gaspé Peninsula, and for three new standard radio stations have been recommended by the Board of Broadcast Governors for approval by the government.

The board, in a lengthy list of findings Monday, also recommended approval of a licence for a new CBC frequency modulation (FM) station at Van couver to broadcast in French. The new TV station at Causapsal would be established by La Compagnie de Radiodiffusion de Matane Inc.

Among applicants for the new standard AM radio stations who won board recommendations for approval are: A company represented by Jean M. Lezault, at Ste. Anne des Monts, Que.

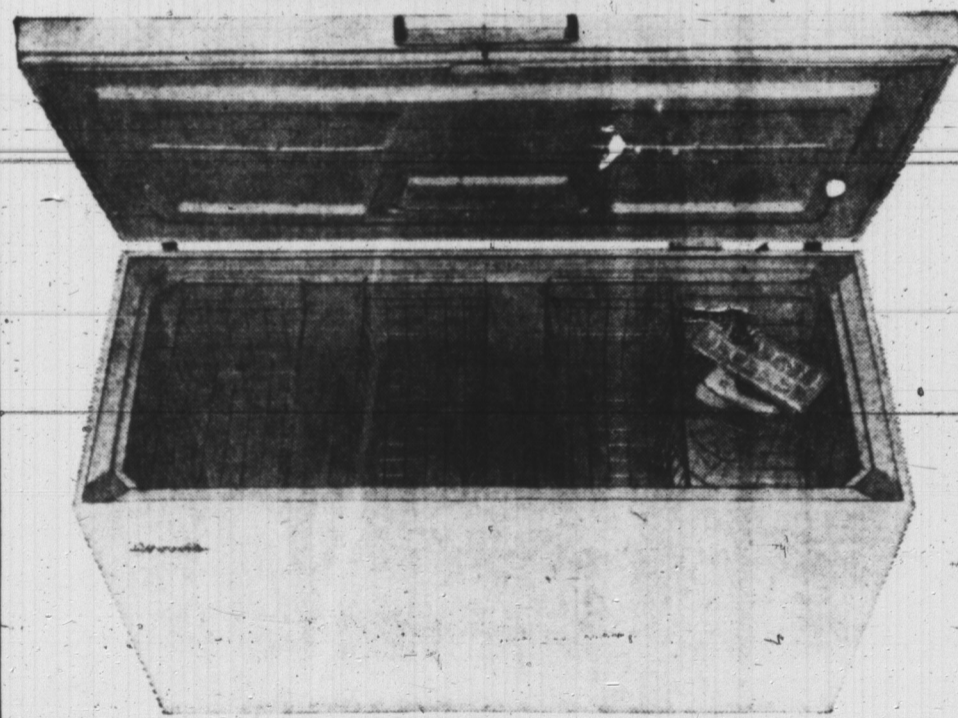

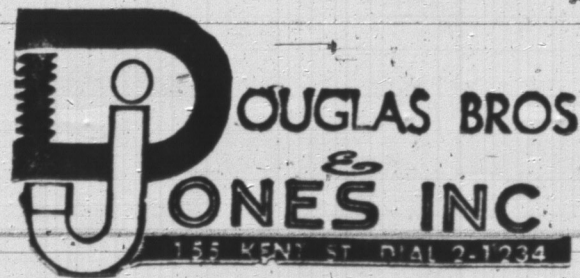
