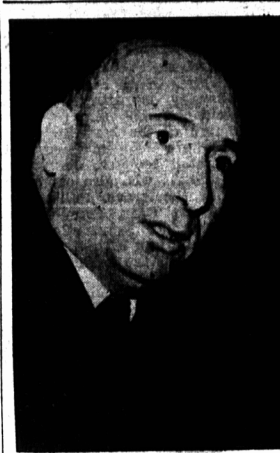

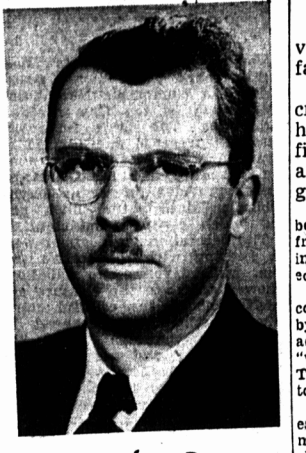

HALIFAX (CP) — The weather office here says the Maritimes are just on the edge of a large storm centred in the Atlantic; skies are mostly cloudy, and there are widely scattered snowdrifts.

Another disturbance is moving rapidly southeastward across Ontario accompanied by an area of continuous snow and is expected to move out into the Atlantic south of Yarmouth in the afternoon. Six to twelve hours of light snow is expected in most of the district Tuesday, with snowfall amounts ranging from two to four inches.
