**Education Fever Strikes
Maoris In New Zealand**

AUCKLAND (CP)—A remarkable and welcome outbreak of education fever has struck adult Maoris in New Zealand's Auckland area. All over the district they are enrolling in night classes with the aim of taking school graduation examinations. All authorities agree that education is the key to the future progress of the Maoris, New Zealand's native race. Individual Maoris have won high academic regard and have filled posts as professors. But far too few have gained advanced qualifications.

The proportion attending universities is still far below that of the white population, despite a widespread campaign and the creation of many special bursaries and scholarships. Too many leave school at the minimum legal age of 15 and take well-paid but dead-end jobs in unskilled labor. Suddenly, without special campaigns or awards, the education idea has caught on among adult Maoris.

golden. Add chicken; dust with salt; saute 5 min. on each side. Lower heat; pour in chicken broth; stir in Tabasco, cloves and cinnamon. Cover. Simmer 1 hr. or until fork-tender. Remove chicken sections. Leave in cloves.

Mix cornstarch, lemon juice and 1/2 tsp. cold water; stir into liquid in skillet. Stir-cook until boiling. Add sour cream. Return chicken to sauce in skillet, and heat through. Stir additional butter into hot rice with a fork. Arrange chicken sections on a deep platter. Border rice around chicken. Serves 6 persons with "good appetites."

THE CHEF EXPLAINS
In Persian cooking, ground cinnamon is added whenever pepper is used. The same trick works out even more happily with cinnamon and Tabasco.

HOUSEHOLD HINTS

Rid Baby's plastic and rubber pants of odor by rinsing well in a baking soda solution.

When hand-hemming, use a buttonhole stitch every three inches. Should thread break, the buttonhole stitch keeps the hem put.

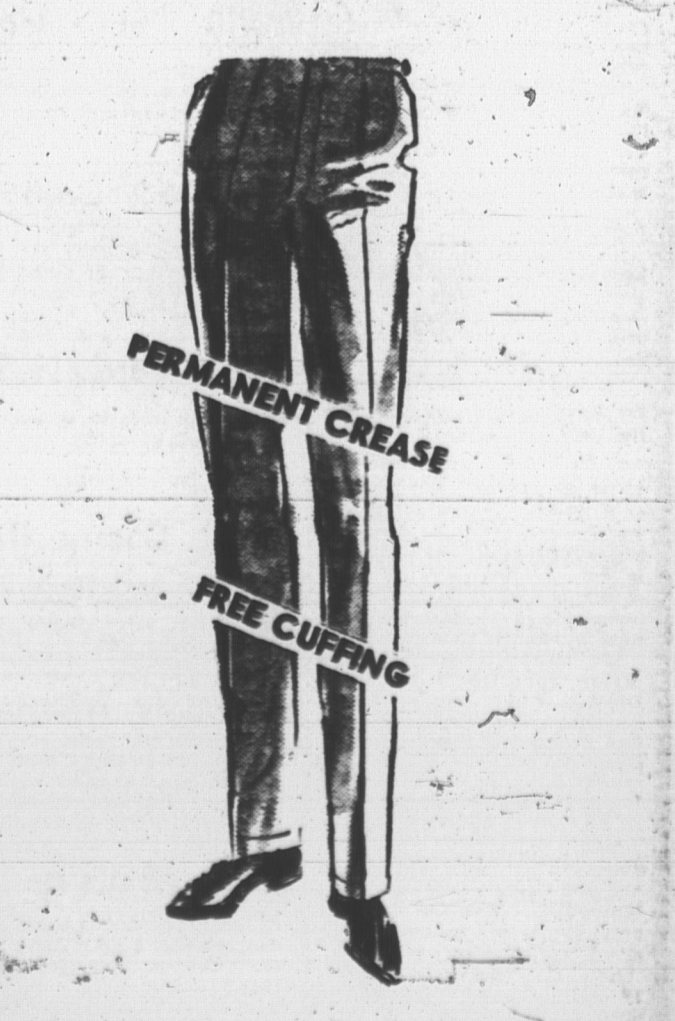
