WARD FIVE EAST CENTRAL "A" SOUTH

The TWENTY-NINTH Polling Division shall comprise that part of Ward Five bounded on the East by Prince Street and Upper Prince Street, on the South by Fitzroy Street, on the West by Great George Street and Elm Avenue, on the North by Alley Street. The Poll shall be held at Mr. John Mullin's, 24 Elm Avenue.

WARD FIVE EAST CENTRAL "B"

The THIRTIETH Polling Division shall comprise that part of Ward Five bounded on the East by Hillsboro Street and Upper Hillsboro Street and a line in continuation thereof North to the City Limits, on the South by Fitzroy Street, on the West by Prince Street and Upper Prince Street and a line in continuation thereof North to the City Limits, and on the North by the City Limits. The Poll shall be held at John MacKinnon's, 16 School Street.

WARD FIVE EAST "A"

The THIRTY-FIRST Polling Division shall comprise that part of Ward Five bounded on the South by Euston Street and Longworth Avenue, on the West by Upper Hillsboro Street and a line in continuation thereof to the City Limits, and on the North by the City Limits. The Poll shall be held at Mrs. Shaw's, 40 Orlebar Street.

WARD FIVE EAST "B"

The THIRTY-SECOND Polling Division, A and B, shall comprise that part of Ward Five bounded on the West by Hillsboro Street, on the North by Euston Street and Longworth Avenue to Pleasant Street, on the East by Pleasant Street to Euston Street, thence along Euston Street including the South side thereof to Edward Street, on the East by Edward Street to Fitzroy Street to Hillsboro Street. The Poll shall be held at The Forum, Fitzroy Street.

WARD FIVE EAST "C"

The THIRTY-FIFTH Polling Division shall comprise that part of Charlottetown Royalty bounded on the West by the Malpeque Road, on the South by the City Limits and St. Peter's Road, on the East by the Mount Edward Road, on the North by the Royalty Road. The Poll shall be held at Ivan Williams', Malpeque Road.

ROYALTY CENTRAL "B"

The THIRTY-SIXTH Polling Division shall comprise that part of Charlottetown Royalty bounded on the West by Mount Edward Road, on the South by the St. Peter's Road, on the East by Brackley Point Road, on the North by the Royalty Road. The Poll shall be held at Borden MacDonald's Dance Hall, St. Peter's Road.

ROYALTY EAST "A"
