WEARS LI HUNG CHANG THE THREE-EYED PEACOCK PLUME AND YELLOW JACKET. Chinese Nobility, From Emperor to Petty Counts—How Li Hung Became a Duke—A Million Dollars' Worth of Birthday Presents—Honors After Death.

As to the yellow jacket, this is only to be used when the man who has it is in personal attendance upon an emperor in the field or upon journeys. It is a sort of a riding cap, and it has been awarded to two Europeans, one of whom was Gen. Gordon and the other a Frenchman named Foo Chow.

He has risen in rank as well as in power. He is now an earl and when I saw him last summer at a banquet in his palace his head was decorated with a cap out of the best of which stuff his three-eyed peacock feather, says Frank Carpenter.
