GRAIN

WINNIPEG, (CP) - Prices generally took on an easier tone in inactive trade Monday on the Winnipeg grain exchange.

A cargo of Canadian barley was reported sold during the week-end to Denmark, while smaller parcels went to the United States.

Some of this business was reflected in the barley trade. Oats came in for domestic shipper buying. American interests also picked up the deferred months.

An occasional processor order appeared in flux, while the orders were mostly local. The odd American order also came out in the open.

Export loadings of Canadian wheat during the week-end totalled more than 2,500,000 bushels, including: United Kingdom 940,000; Belgium 20,000; Republic of Ireland 600,000; Germany 280,000; Pakistan 360,000; and Japan 320,000.

Prices for Class Two wheat advanced 1-8 cent from Friday. IWA prices advanced one-eighth cent.
