When distance is greater than 10 miles, for twenty words or under.

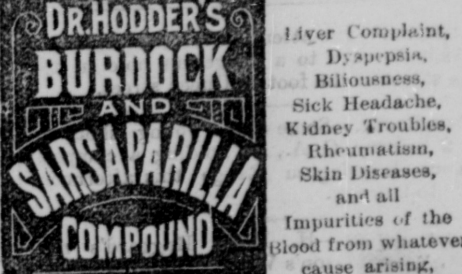
