Platinums a Feature

Standard platinum foxes were a feature of the show and as usual were much admired. They are certainly very eye-catching and appealing to one who loves a good fox. Although the entry list was not a large one competition was keen. The results and the winners of the various types appear in the prize list below.

The championship for this group in adults was won by Ernest T. Mill, Kensington, with W. E. Jenkins, Summerside, owing the reserve. W. E. Jenkins had the champion standard platinum pup with G. F. Cameron, Summerside, holding the reserve. The bringing together of these champions showed Ernest T. Mill winner of the grand championship for standard platinums with Willowgrove Miss 94B, reserve W. E. Jenkins, Upsworth 58D.

Standard white-marked silvers have been cut down in the prize catalogue to one class, extra light. In the adult section Roy Woodside the champion and also had the side was the winner and reserve champion. The champion standard white-marked silver pup and reserve was won by Ernest T. Mill and the grand champion standard white-marked silver was Malpeque View 4Z, owned by Roy Woodside, who also had the reserve champion.

Mink Judging Begins

With the fox judging completed, judging of standard mink and mutations commenced about 2 p.m. with John Maloney of Hudson's Bay Company, Montreal, who had arrived earlier in the forenoon by plane, officiating. Mr. Maloney is known through the fur

world, not only in Great Britain and Europe but also in the United States and of course in Canada. He is an expert who has served an apprenticeship under the best fur men in Europe, was for years with the world-famous firm of Revillon Freres and has been for the past 10 years with the Hudson's Bay Company of London, New York and Montreal. He is a man of commanding appearance can speak fluently and interestingly on any topic connected with the fur trade, is genial and extremely well liked wherever he goes. It was a nice gesture for the Hudson's Bay Company to loan him to the Provincial Fox Exhibition to act as judge of mink. He had previously judged at Amherst. If Mr. Maloney could be spared he would not doubt be judging mink from the Atlantic to the Pacific.

The light was bad, due to the rain and dull, heavy mist but notwithstanding the difficulty quite a number of sections of the prize list had been tabled when the light gave out around 4.30 p.m.

Largest Mink Show

This mink show is the fifth staged by the Fox and Mink Exhibitors Association and it is the largest, with the most variety of types and it is likely when it is completed that Judge Maloney will see a marked improvement in quality from the previous years.

The standards, of course, were the first to be scrutinized and in this class the entries of Ernest Kenney and Son, Atwood's Brook, Nova Scotia carried off the top placings in the four sections, also the championships for males and females and grand and reserve championships. B. B. Jones, Bunsbury placed next with honors in these classes. The writer looked over the Kenney exhibits and in a conversation with a helper was told the ranch was in a very favorable position to secure cheap feed because of its proximity to a fish-filling plant where offal could be obtained at less than a cent a pound. That formed the principal diet of the large strong looking mink exhibited by Kenney and Son.

Just prior to closing for the afternoon, class two pastels was tabulated, with 10 entries and B. B. Jones was first, third and fourth, with Leigh Clark, Summerside, winning second, fifth and sixth. Mr. Jones is president of the Fox and Mink Exhibition Association

and it will be remembered, carried off a large share of the honors with his pastels last week at Amherst.

This morning at 9 o'clock or shortly after judging of mink will be resumed and will probably be concluded early in the afternoon. There are many very beautiful types that will be exhibited this morning. Top ranking in price at least goes to sapphires, a mutation that was developed only a few years ago and when first placed on sale realized as high as \$1,000 a pair and live sapphires sold as high as \$5,000 for breeding purposes.

To anyone interested in fur farming a visit to the Exhibition Fox Pavilion this morning will be worth while as there will be seen some of the finest production of the fur farmers art.
