WASHINGTON (AP)—The atomic energy commission Wednesday announced the signing of a contract with the Yankee Atomic Electric Co. of Boston to assist the company in development and operation of a large-scale power plant in Rowe, Mass.

Yankee will bear construction costs estimated at \$4,500,000. Under the contract the company will build and operate a pressurized, light water-cooled and moderated reactor and generating equipment with a minimum capacity of 134,000 kilowatts.
