

IN MEMORIAM

PERCY EDWARD DOWNE

With a suddenness that shocked all who knew and loved him, the death occurred in his sleep on the early hours of February 2, of Percy Edward Downe in his 44th year.

In good health and active up to the time of his passing, the late Mr. Downe was marked by the large stones of his life by the large number of friends he made in all walks of life. To his contemporaries he was a true and understanding friend, while to the younger people, he was ever ready to ease their burdens and lead them through the obstacles to a happier life.

Never happier than when surrounded by his family, his home was always the centre of his activities and his hospitality was renowned. The late Mr. Downe will be sadly missed by his cheerfulness and kindness to all who needed help, by his own efforts or through his association with the Salvation Army, of which he was a faithful servant.

A very large congregation attended to the funeral which was held in the St. John's and all parts of the Island, and which filled the Salvation Army Citadel to capacity while scores remained outside in the inclement weather.

Senior Captain Leslie Titcombe, assisted by the Reverend A. F. MacLean, conducted the service, during which two favourite hymns were sung, "The Lord is My Shepherd" and "There's a Friend for Every Man."

The Reverend A. F. MacLean read suitable portions of scripture from the Book of Revelations and the Gospel according to St. John.

Following the Prayer of St. Gregory over the Death and Consolation, Captain Titcombe based the Scripture Lesson and Tribute on the words of Paul found in I Corinthians 13:4-7: "Love is patient, love is kind, love is not envious, love is not puffed up, love is not jealous, love is not arrogant, love is not boastful, love is not proud, love is not irritable, love is not angry, love is not vindictive, love does not rejoice in the truth of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love Him."

Rich in graces that money cannot buy, the earthly home so recently left was illustrated, in part, by the heavenly home which the son of God has promised to all that love Him.

The closing prayer of Obedience in Life that men might conquer Death brought the service to its close. It was estimated that almost 400 people then filed past in silent respect, paying their farewells to a man amongst men. The pallbearers were Messrs. Albert Younker, Harold Stead, Harold Cudmore, Roland Wood, D. K. MacLeod and Hon. B. Earle MacLeod.

The late Mr. Downe was born in the City, a son of the late Mr. and Mrs. William Downe, and leaves to mourn his sudden passing his wife, the former Catherine Cameron of this city and six daughters, three sons and five grand-children. The sons are Edward and City Police Constables Robert Downe and Russell Downe. The daughter are Florence, Mrs. Hawley Crockett, Kathryn, Mrs. John Hermann, Minnie, Mrs. Sydney Clay, Roma, Mrs. Joseph Dunning, all of this city; and Olive, Mrs. Peter Hawkes Loquelin, Quebec.

Also surviving are two brothers, Walter, Charlottetown, and Jack, Charlottetown; a half-brother, William, Charlottetown, and a half-sister, Bertha, residing in Western Canada, and 16 grand-children.
