The girl with the bust is Sabrina, nee Norma Sykes, known the length and breadth of the British Isles as "television's dumb blonde." She has become famous by the simple process of standing in front of the cameras and breathing. The vital statistic is 41 times.  
Sabrina's appearance before the Royal Family and among the peers of the realm created a bigger shock than the victory of an eight-year-old gelding named Bonhomie in the day's feature race, and Bonhomie paid 76 to 1 on the tote.
