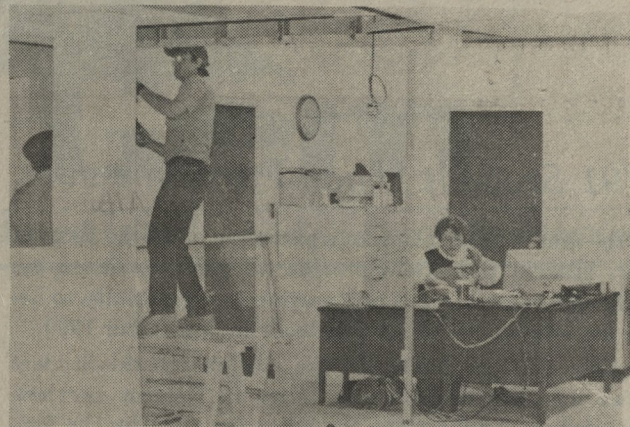

In Winkfield's words "**Hay Fever** is a hilarious romp which plays society's normal values against the irreverent attitude of a zany family."

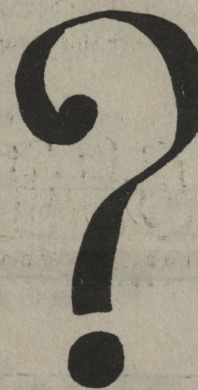
