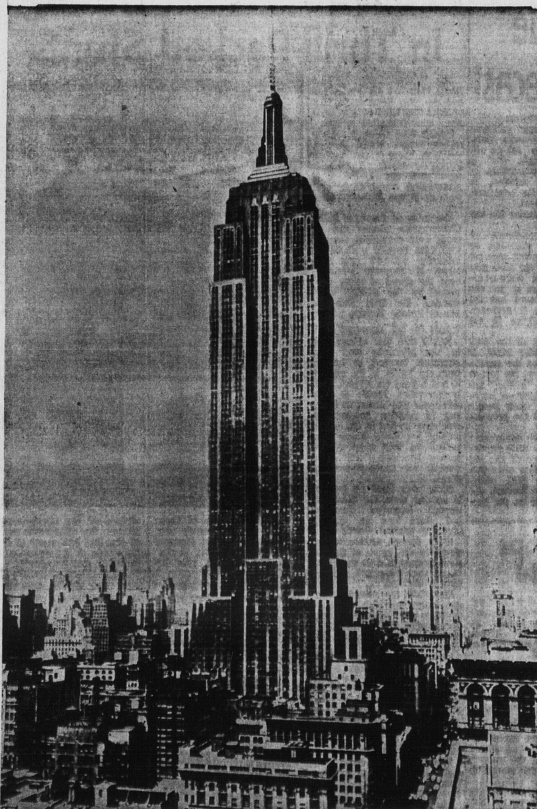

Points can be obtained only by securing new and renewal subscriptions for The Guardian and/or Evening Patriot. No one subscription will be accepted for a period longer than two years.

Subscriptions will be accepted for anywhere.

PRESENT SUBSCRIPTIONS CANNOT BE CHANGED FROM ONE MEMBER'S NAME TO ANOTHER OF THE SAME HOUSEHOLD AND BE CLASSED AS A NEW SUBSCRIPTION

All points earned for subscriptions may be withheld or published at the discretion of the Contest Manager of the New York Tour Contest.

Each contestant must **TURN IN ALL MONEY COLLECTED AT LEAST ONCE A WEEK.**

Points are not transferable from one contestant to another.

If a contestant wishes to withdraw from the Tour Contest, she may transfer her points to a subscriber but said substitute must be a new candidate who has not before entered the present contest.
