Lumber Exports.

The Manufacturers' Gazette says: "It is a somewhat singular fact that Canada exports several million dollars worth of lumber each year more to the United States than to Great Britain. Thus, in 1895 Canada's total export of forest products to Great Britain figured \$11,106,482, while to the United States that aggregate showed \$14,841,455 worth. Yet with this enormous export of lumber to the United States and to Great Britain, the value of Canada's forest products is about \$80,000,000 per annum, leaving a balance for local consumption of about \$55,000,000, nearly 70 per cent. of its forest products, and equaling more than \$11 per head of the population. It is somewhat surprising to note that Canada uses twice as much lumber at home as she ships abroad. This is a similar fact to that which we have noted concerning the largely increasing local consumption of lumber in the New England States."
