

Fish Catches Poor In Soviet Union

MOSCOW (AP) — Fishing is so bad in the Soviet Union it has experts of the Academy of Sciences worried, the Literary Gazette said Thursday.

The Literary Gazette, tri-weekly organ of the Soviet Writers' Union said the yield of valuable food fish in the Caspian Sea dropped from 619,000,000 kilograms in 1913 to 277,000,000 in 1954.

A group of academy scientists gave these reasons for the decline:

Hydro-electric projects make it impossible to maintain proper water levels; fishing trusts ignore regulations and fish out many areas at the spawning season and water contamination by industry

CONTRACT BRIDGE

South dealer East-West vulnerable.

The bidding:
South West North East

Opening lead—jack of hearts.

The question of which long suit to establish in notrump play, when there is a choice of suits, is not one which readily lends itself to flat rules. The approach to this subdivision of dummy play is paralleled by the difficulties which beset the declarer in his approach to the play of most hands.

While general bidding principles can be memorized and mastered, and the serious student can learn to apply the proper principle to the bidding of a particular hand, dummy play cannot be categorized so easily.

The problems to which a declarer may be subject do not fall into neatly defined families that allow the dummy player to pluck a general principle from out of the air and apply it to the situation at hand.

Thus, in today's hand, the declarer should not allow himself to be guided by such generalities as: always attack your longest suit, or your strongest suit, or similar doctrines. Each hand has to rest on its own merits. The declarer should apply as best he can, on a common sense basis, the tools at his command to the goal he has in view.

South starts with seven sure tricks. The two tricks he is short of his contract obviously have to come from either spades or clubs. Each suit is then visually tested by the declarer to see which of them is more apt to deliver the contract.

If he attacks clubs, continues the declarer, what will be the result? The answer is: four no-trump. Three additional tricks sprout, once the ace and queen of clubs are out of the way.

Clearly, then, the club suit is the one to be established. In this hand, the weaker suit gets the nod.
