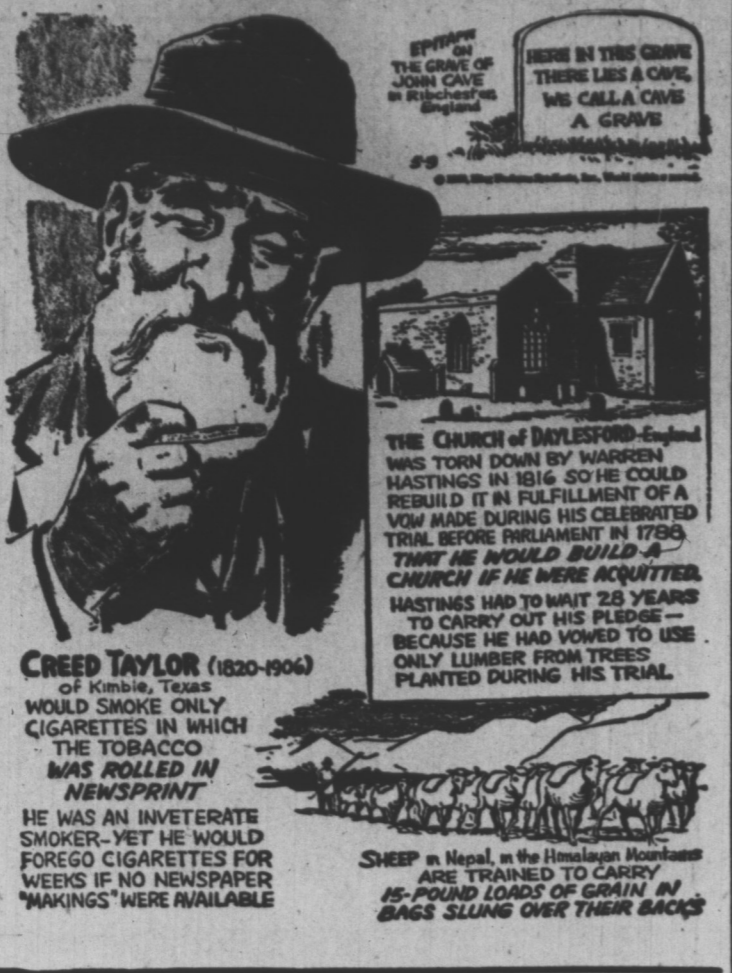

KELOWNA, B.C. (CP) Stuart (Nipper) Riddell, one-time sheep owner, air force man and gear rancher, Thursday is captain of his own ship sailing somewhere on the Pacific bound for the south seas.

A former Kelowna resident, he sold a sheep ranch to purchase the 60-foot ketch Romayne, which he has pointed out of San Francisco toward Mazatlan on the west coast of Mexico.

From there he intends to strike directly across the Pacific to Nuka Hiva, port of entry for French Oceania, then through the Tuamotu Archipelago to Tahiti and the Leeward Islands.

After that, skipper-owner Riddell is not sure.
