Gastric and Intestinal Parasites.
Botts are a species of parasites, the product of the horse-fly (Estrus Equi.) During the summer months these flies make their appearance, and are a continual source of annoyance to the animal, leaving on the surface of the body small ovoid eggs or larvae, which adhere to the hair, particularly to the long hair beneath the jaws, and also on the fore legs, from which they are either kicked off by the horse or fall into the animal's food, thus working their way by the mouth and gullet to the stomach, where they take apartments for the winter, to vacate in the spring. Shortly after their arrival in the stomach these embryos begin to assume the regular form of parasites, furnished with hooks so as to obtain a firm hold of the lining of the stomach, and remain there until the following spring, when they pass through the intestinal canals and make their exit with the manure, remaining dormant until the heat of the sun's rays excites their development, when they assume the proportions of a full-grown horse-fly, to perform the functions of their sires the previous year.

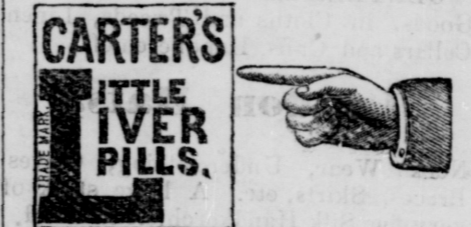

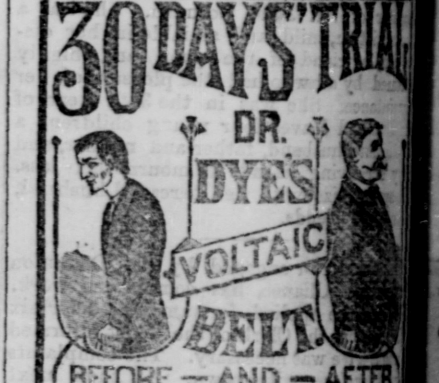
