

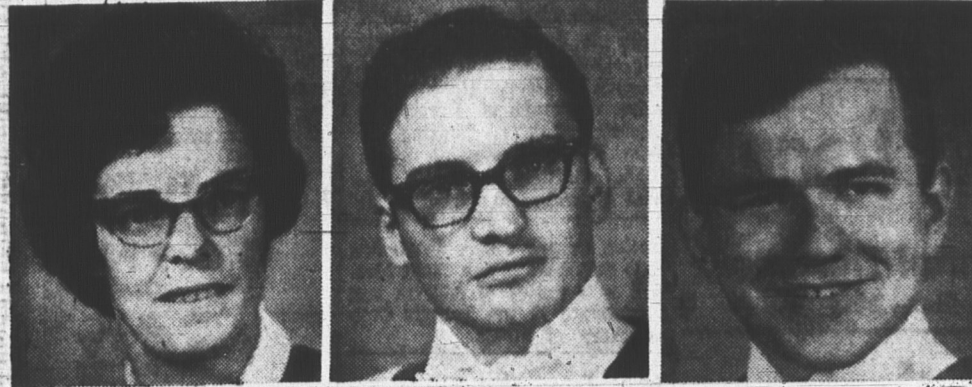
Saint Dunstan's Honors Record Number Of Graduates Today

Spotlight Will Focus On SDU Class Of '66

Some 75 senior students of St. Dunstan's University will attain a long sought goal when they are presented with their diplomas and certificates indicating that they have been awarded their degree or are now set for the final stage in the quest for a professional career.

The ceremonies will take place this afternoon, commencing at 3 o'clock at SDU with the Chancellor of the university Most Rev. Malcolm A. MacEachern, Bishop of Charlottetown as chairman and who will also confer the degrees, certificates and diplomas on the successful students.

Those receiving degrees will have completed the prescribed courses in the fields of education, arts, sciences and commerce. The diplomas and certificates will go to those who have completed the initial stages in the fields of engineering and medicine.

In addition to the regular class of graduates, two prominent Islanders will be conferred with Honorary Doctor of Laws degrees. They are: Lieutenant-Governor W.J. MacDonald, who will also deliver the address to the graduates; and Rev. Canon E.M. Malone, a prominent Anglican priest and former rector of St. Peter's Cathedral and a past president of the P.E.I. branch of the Canadian Bible Society.
