

Radical Proposal Is Made For German Reunification

BONN (Reuters) — Rainer Barzel parliamentary leader of West Germany's ruling Christian Democrats, dropped a bombshell with radical proposals for a reunited Germany in which Soviet troops still could be based.

The West German capital was stunned when an advance report was circulated of a speech Barzel was due to make in the West German embassy in Washington and again Friday in New York.

Informed sources said Barzel, widely tipped as a future chancellor, had not cleared his speech in advance with Chancellor Ludwig Erhard.

His speech contained proposals on German reunification — the dominating issue in German politics — which go far beyond anything ever mooted by

Untidiness Has Value

KINGSTON (CP) — A certain amount of untidiness is good for agencies doing educational work in Africa, said a report presented here at the first plenary session of the Canadian Council of Churches' Focus on Africa.

The report, a summation of discussion carried on in a working group looking at Canada's role in Africa, through non-church voluntary agencies, said a characteristic of those agencies is a loose organizational structure.

This looseness, or untidiness, permitted more personal initiative, ideas and contributions towards helping Africa than does high centralization, the report said.

Volunteers of organizations like Canadian University Students Overseas (CUSO) can establish themselves with Africans easily because they are representatives of non-colonial powers, the report added.

CUSO volunteers, for the large part, remain inconspicuous because they quietly get on with their jobs of educating and providing technical assistance to Africans.

Volunteer agencies should carefully avoid the enlistment of do-gooders — people who think they have all the answers to the problems of others, the report suggested.

Four Experimental Designs Shown By American Motors

NEW YORK (AP) — American Motors has showed off four new experimental sports car designs, including its version of the interchangeable automobile, with built-in safety features.

One experimental design, the Cavalier, has four doors, each identically paneled. It also has identical front and rear fenders and bumpers, and the hood panel and trunk lid are interchangeable.

American Motors President Roy Abernethy said the interchangeable features of the Cavalier "could provide savings of 25 per cent or more in body tooling costs."

The Cavalier wheelbase is 108 inches. Overall length is 173 inches. Height — 50 inches — weighs 655 pounds, and its low silhouette is set off by 13-inch spoked wheels.

U.S. Scientists Are Preparing For Two More Moon Probes

CAPE KENNEDY, Fla. (AP) — Still beaming over the successful soft-landing of Surveyor I, U.S. scientists are preparing two more moon probes for launching in the next three weeks — aiming to put them in lunar orbit.

On June 30, an interplanetary monitoring platform is to be launched toward an orbit ranging from about 800 to 4,000 miles above the moon's surface. It is to study radiation, magnetic fields, micro-meteoroids and other scientific properties in the vicinity of the moon.

On July 11, a spacecraft called Lunar Orbiter is to be fired into an orbital path intended to pass as close as 28 miles to the moon. It carries television cameras to photograph potential landing areas.

Hopefully, Lunar Orbiter will obtain pictures of the two areas in the Ocean of Storms where Surveyor I and the Soviet Union's Luna IX made soft-landings. Such pictures would provide lunar detail well beyond the range of the photos made on the surface.

The Ocean of Storms is considered a possible touchdown spot for American astronauts. Luna IX sent back nine pictures while Surveyor I totalled more than 10,000 transmissions that revealed a rock-strewn plain apparently firm enough to support a manned expedition.
