WINNIPEG, July 16 - (CP) - Coarse grain prices showed an easier tone today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. Further export demand for barley was indicated along with buying by American milling interests. Shippers took oats. Flax also brought some export buying. Offerings showed a tendency to increase and were influenced in part by declines on U.S. grain markets and predictions of large coarse grain production in Canada this year by the Federal Government. No information was available on overnight loadings of Canadian wheat for export. Prices of class two wheat were down 1/2 cents. Prices of I.W.A. wheat were up 1/2 cents.
