The P.E.I. Womens Volleyball league is the first league for women to be set up in the province. At Holland Cove Camp this summer, representatives from three schools in the province were enrolled in an intensive five day training program for volleyball and returned to their local communities to form their

own teams. included in this group were Montague, Charlottetown and Charlottetown Rural. These three teams as well as U.P.E.I., Formula 1 (a Charlottetown junior team), Prince County Juniors and Prince County Seniors make up the league.
