Grain

WINNIPEG, July 17 - (CP) - Most prices showed a lower trend in a moderately active session of coarse grain future trading today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. There was some increase in offerings and hedging sales. A hesitation in some U.S. grain prices and a lack of aggressive demand contributed to the decline. Export interests were credited with purchases of barley on the recession. Some shipping demand was indicated in oats. There was industrial buying in flax. Rye declines reflected sharp U.S. price losses. Export loadings of Canadian wheat overnight included United Kingdom 1,100,000 bushels, Eira 155,000, Norway 300,000, India 360,000 and a small parcel to the Netherlands. Prices of class two wheat were up 2 cents. Prices of I.W.A. wheat were unchanged. Closing prices: Oats - July 80 1/2; Oct. 80 1/2; Dec. 79 1/2; May 81 1/2.
