I admire a man who never gets great enough to refuse to express his opinion upon small objects. There is a great deal in the simple fact that Mr. Beecher will say in a great company: "I love apple pie and like to farm during the summer months, by lying under an apple tree and going to sleep."

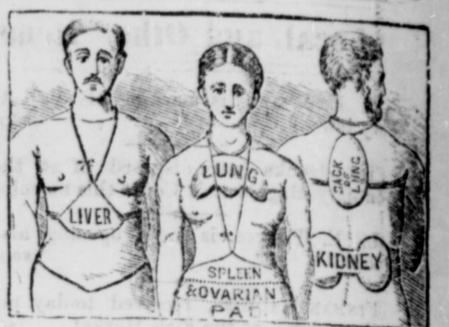
