## Housewife Opens Fund For Widow

BELFAST, Northern Ireland (AP)—An Irish housewife has opened a fund to help the Russian-born widow of the late Lee Harvey Oswald, accused assassin of President Kennedy. Jane Adley, 48, said there was nothing political about her plan. "I simply want to put into practice what President Kennedy himself always preached—brotherhood and tolerance," she told reporters. "I thought Mr. Kennedy was a great man. My husband and teenage son admired him too. I don't know exactly what the poor Russian woman is going through."
