NEW YORK (AP)—The stock market continued its surge ahead Tuesday for the second straight session of bull market enthusiasm. Buying eventually centered in steels and aircrafts and they broadened to the entire market. Railroads came to life late in the session with good price gains.

There were 160 highs and three lows registered.

Volume amounted to 2,560,000 shares.

At the top of the most active list was Radio Corp. up 1 1/2 at 32 1/4 of 77,000 shares. It was followed by RKO Theatres up 3/4 at 7 1/2 and U. S. Steel up 1 at 50 1/4.

Douglas Aircraft was up 6 1/4 at 84 1/4. General Motors was up 1 1/4 at 47 1/4.
