U. S. Steel Report

CLEVELAND, Dec. 9 — (AP) — The magazine, Steel, reports today that government steel distribution plans are meeting growing criticism.

With military requirements taking less than 15 per-cent of total production, producers and consumers are displaying more annoyance over the Controlled Materials Plan, the magazine says.

Steel says they are blaming the government for "contribution to shortages, hampering scheduling and production and forcing manufacturing curtailments."

The magazine, in its weekly summary of the metal-working industry, adds:

"Majority opinion in the industry, it appears, favors limiting controls to military requirements, thus relinquishing the bulk of output for distribution without strings by the separate producers."

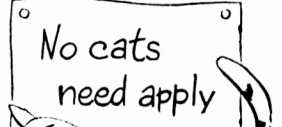
